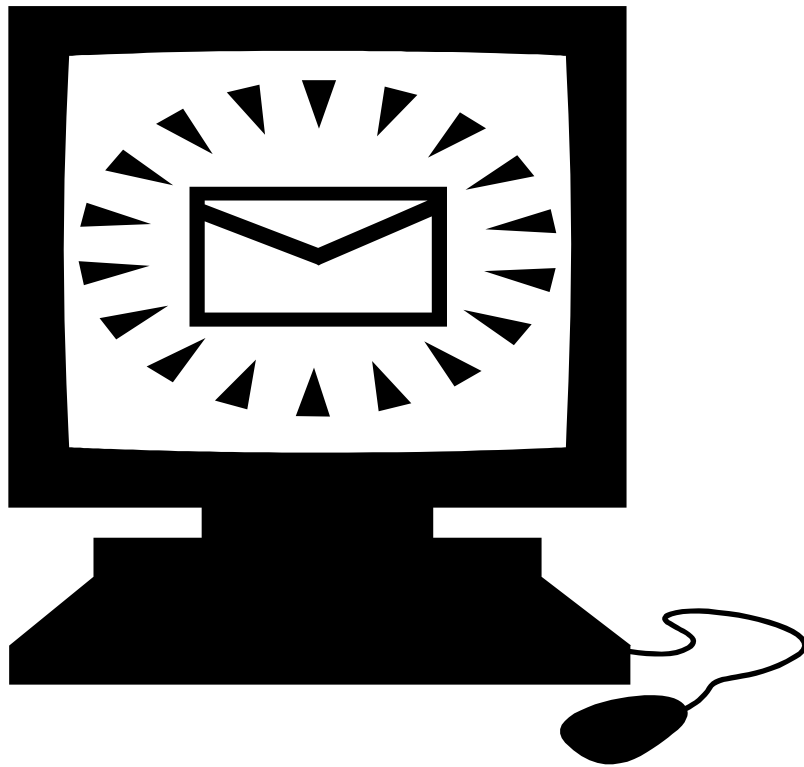

Financial Aid Disbursed

- **Grants represent 93% of the total aid disbursed to students**
- **Federal dollars represent 57% of the payments, with the state and college shares being relatively equal.**
- **Pell Grants represent the largest portion of assistance paid to students.**
- **\$141,418 in Pell Grant funds have been paid to 463 students attending on a <half-time basis.**
