Web Apps indicates the number of applications submitted by students over the Internet, i.e. FAFSA on the Web. Paper apps represents the number of traditional forms filed, i.e. the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). The Percent column indicates the percentage of applications filed over the Internet.

* The ONLINE (Banner Self-Service) Use section represents unduplicated student use of our Banner Self-Service product available to students 24/7. In the secure area of ONLINE, students can track application status and requirements, accept/decline financial aid awards, monitor payments, work-study earnings, loan applications and the like. The report indicates the unduplicated number and percent of students visiting the financial aid section of ONLINE sorted by the student application filing status, Web or Paper, as well as the Total Use.
