CREDIT ENROLLMENT

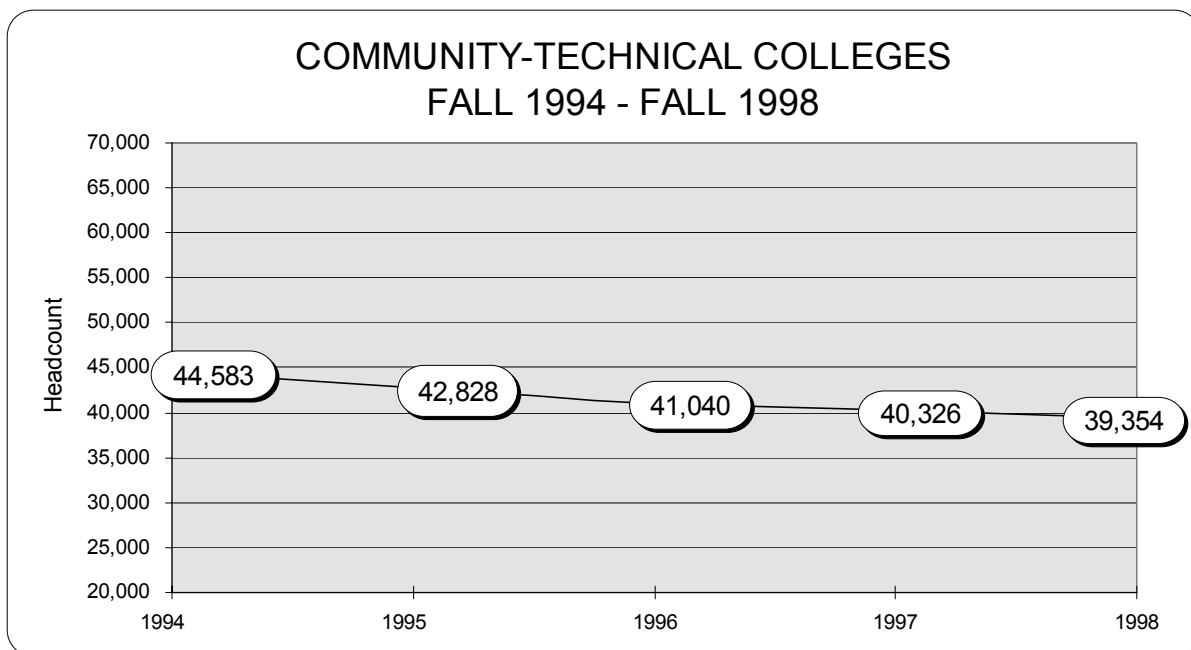
The Community-Technical Colleges' Fall 1998 Combined Fund Credit enrollment is 39,354 students and 19,034 FTE. Compared to Fall 1997, this represents a 2.4% decline in headcount enrollment and a 1.3% decline in FTE enrollment. General Fund headcount enrollment declined 2.1% and 1% in FTE enrollment.

In the Fall 1998 semester, 75.5% of all CTC students attend part-time, and 24.5% of the students attend full-time. The average age of the student population is 30 – 23 for full-time students and 33 for part-timers. Of all CTC students, 25.5% fall into the 20-24 year age bracket, while 41.7% are age 30 or above.

The system's gender composition in the Fall of 1998 is 60.2% women and 39.8% men.

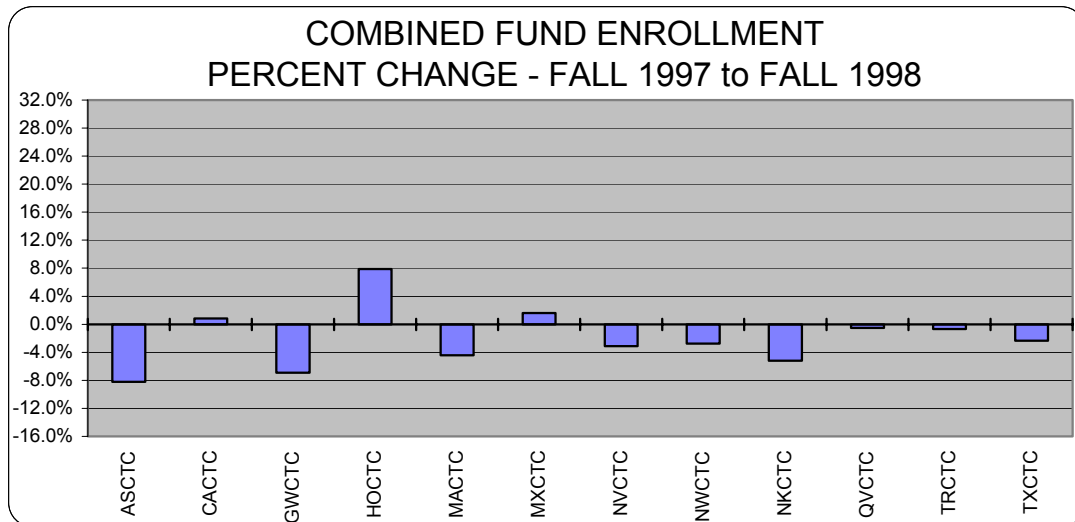
The CTC minority enrollments represent 24.4% of the student body in the Fall of 1998, with Blacks and Hispanics representing 21.3% of the student enrollment.

In the Fall of 1998, 43% of all CTC students are enrolled in occupational programs. Liberal Arts and Sciences and General Studies programs account for an additional 27.7% of all CTC students, and the remaining 29.2% of the students are not enrolled in a specific degree or certificate program.



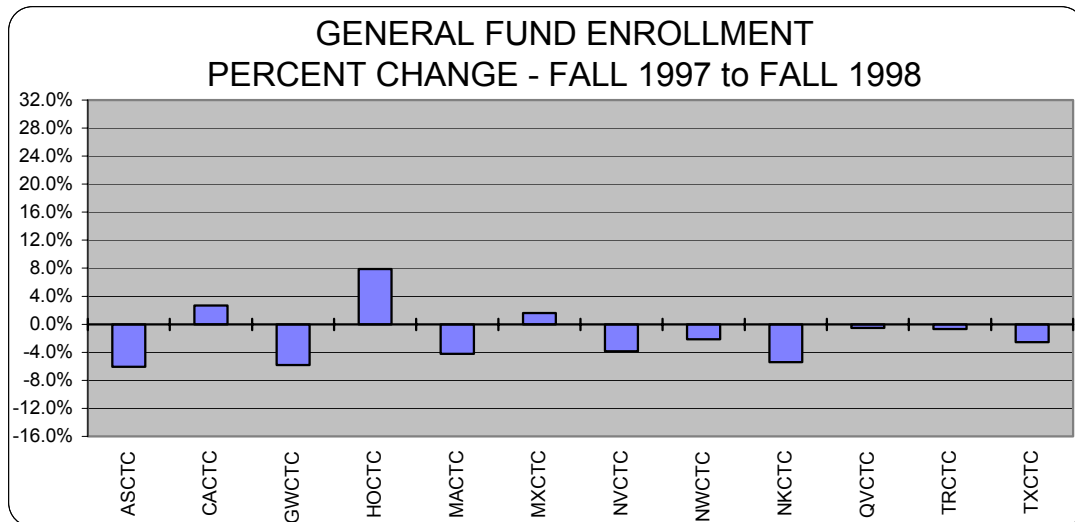

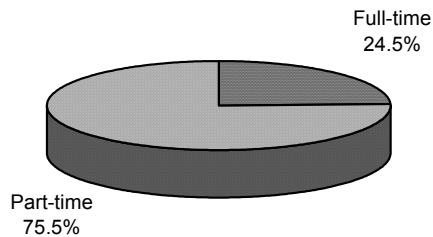

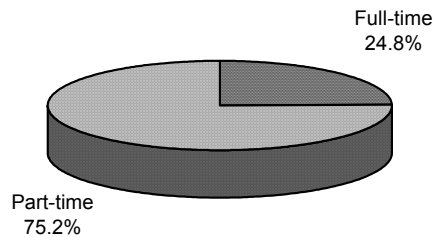
FULL-TIME/PART-TIME

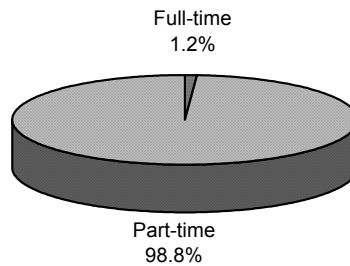
FULL-TIME/PART-TIME

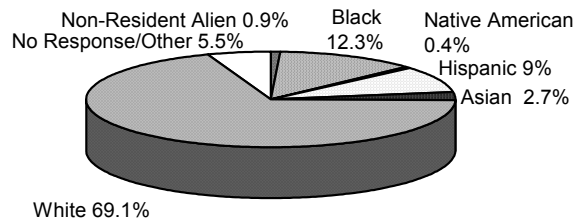

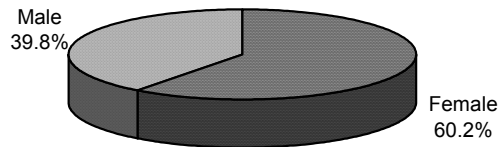
**ETHNIC DISTRIBUTION

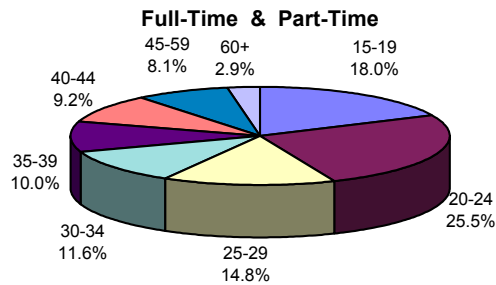
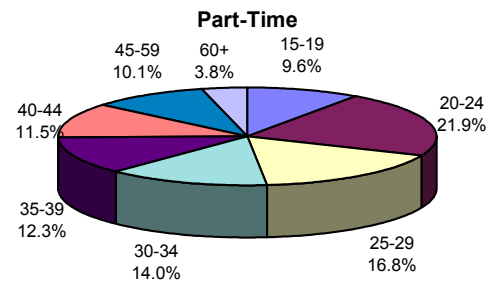
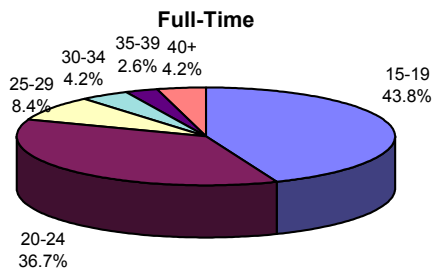
