CREDIT ENROLLMENT

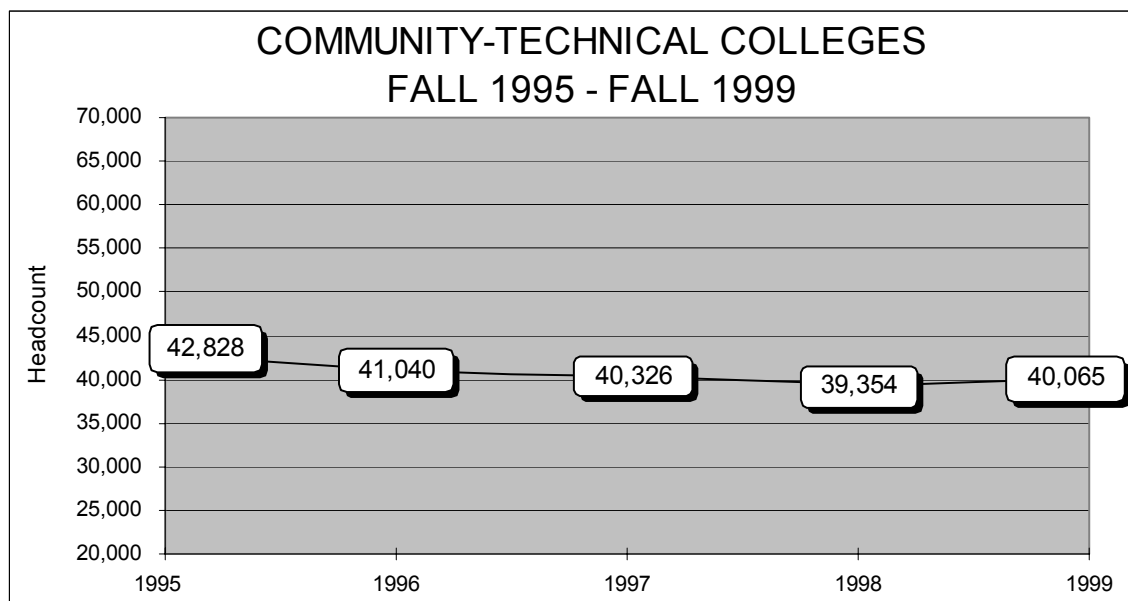
The Community-Technical Colleges' Fall 1999 Combined Fund Credit enrollment was 40,065 students and 19,656 FTE. Compared to Fall 1998, this represents a 1.8% increase in headcount enrollment and a 3.3% increase in FTE enrollment. General Fund headcount enrollment increased 2.1% and 3.4% in FTE enrollment.

In the Fall 1999 semester, 74.1% of all CTC students attended part-time, and 25.9% of the students attended full-time. The average age of the student population was 30 – 23 for full-time students and 33 for part-timers. Of all CTC students, 26.2% fell into the 20-24 year age bracket, while 41.2% were age 30 or above.

The system's gender composition in the Fall of 1999 was 60.2% women and 39.8% men, the same as in the Fall of 1998.

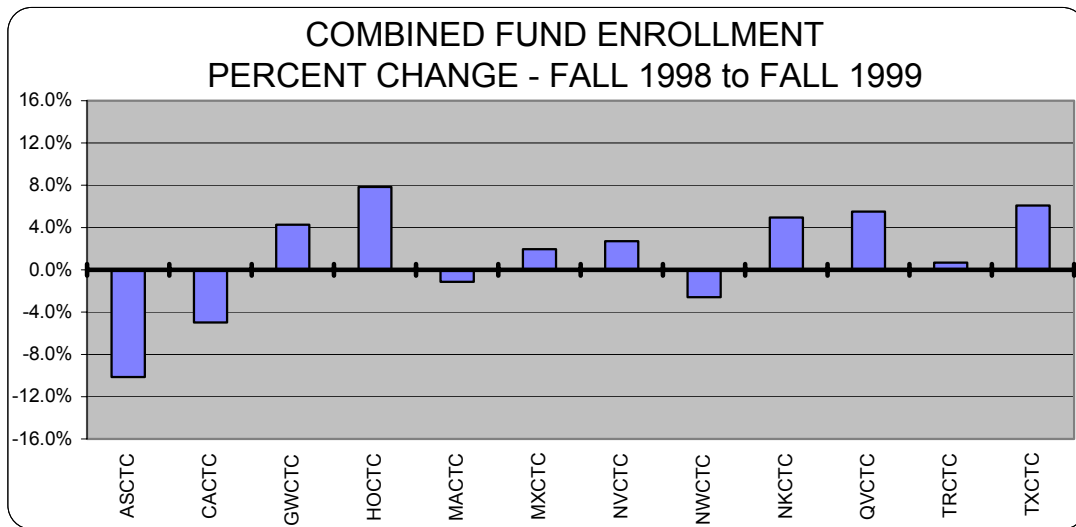
The CTC minority enrollments represented 25.3% of the student body in the Fall of 1999, with Blacks and Hispanics representing 21.9% of the student enrollment.

In the Fall of 1999, 43.4% of all CTC students were enrolled in occupational programs. Liberal Arts and Sciences and General Studies programs accounted for an additional 27.7% of all CTC students, and the remaining 28.9% of the students were not enrolled in a specific degree or certificate program.



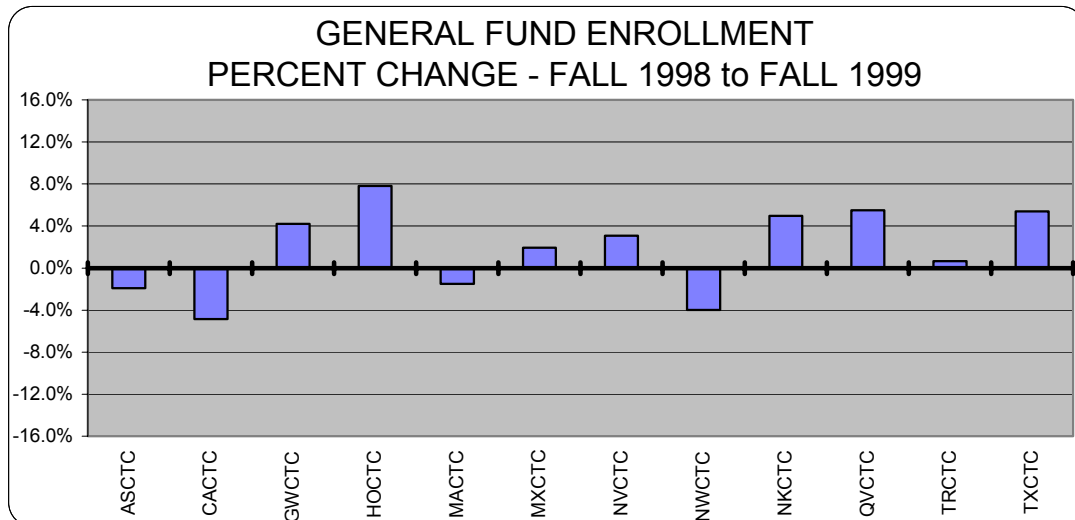

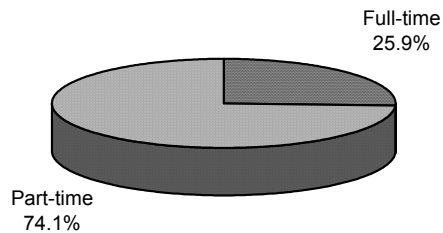

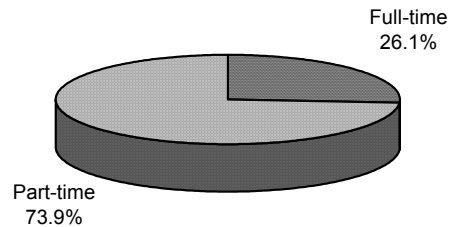
FULL-TIME/PART-TIME

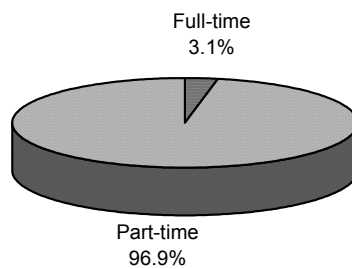
FULL-TIME/PART-TIME

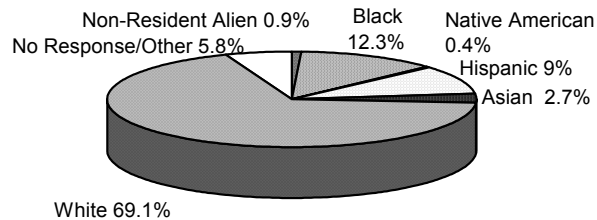
FULL-TIME/PART-TIME

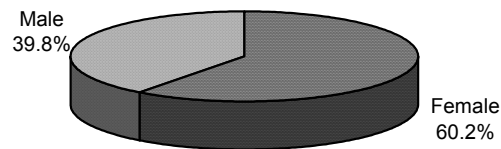
**ETHNIC DISTRIBUTION

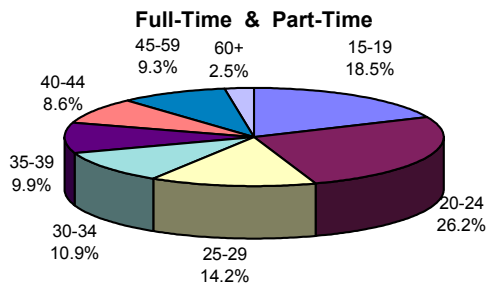
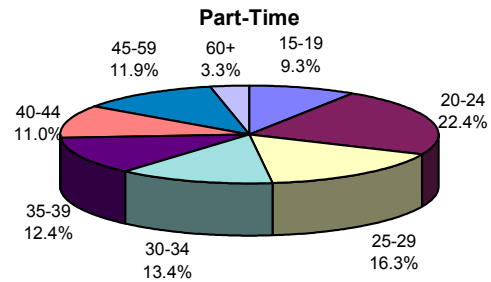
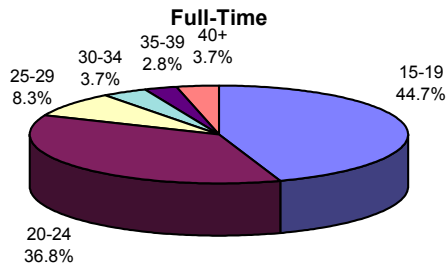
