CREDIT ENROLLMENT

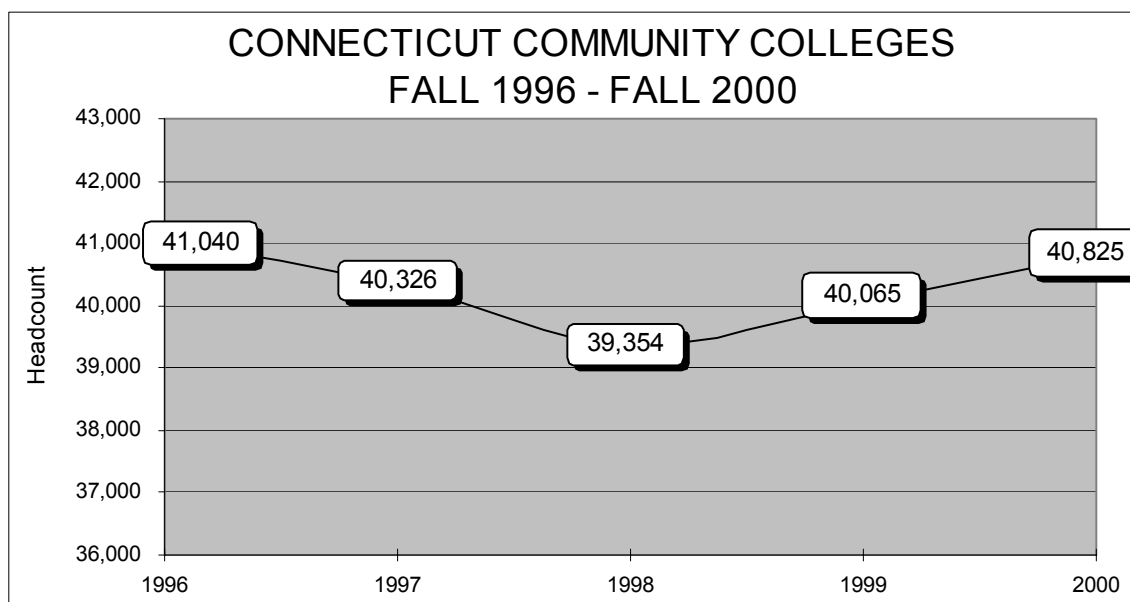
The Connecticut Community Colleges' Fall 2000 Combined Fund Credit Enrollment was 40,825 students and 20,258 FTE. Compared to Fall 1999, this represents a 1.9% increase in headcount enrollment and a 3.1% increase in FTE enrollment. General Fund headcount enrollment increased 1.5% and 3.0% in FTE enrollment.

In the Fall 2000 semester, 73.3% of all Community College students attended part-time, and 26.7% of the students attended full-time. The average age of the student population was 30 – 22 for full-time students and 33 for part-timers. Of all Community College students, 26.5% fell into the 20-24 year age bracket, while 40.7% were age 30 or above.

The system's gender composition in the Fall of 2000 was 60.4% women and 39.6% men, virtually the same as in the Fall of 1999.

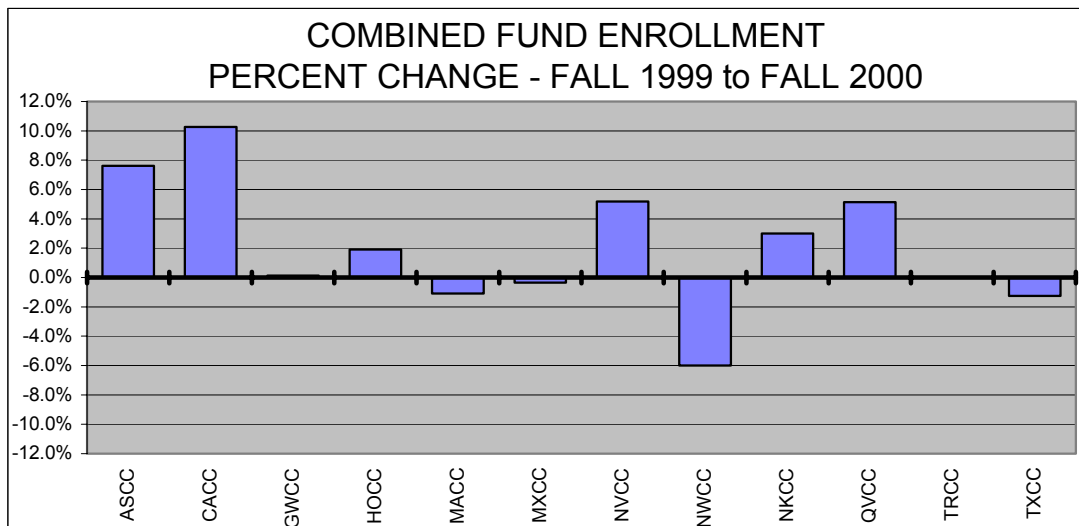
The Community Colleges' minority enrollments represented 27.1% of the student body in the Fall of 2000, with Blacks and Hispanics representing 23.7% of the student enrollment.

In the Fall of 2000, 41.6% of all Community College students were enrolled in occupational programs. Liberal Arts and Sciences and General Studies programs accounted for an additional 27.5% of all Community College students, and the remaining 30.9% of the students were not enrolled in a specific degree or certificate program.



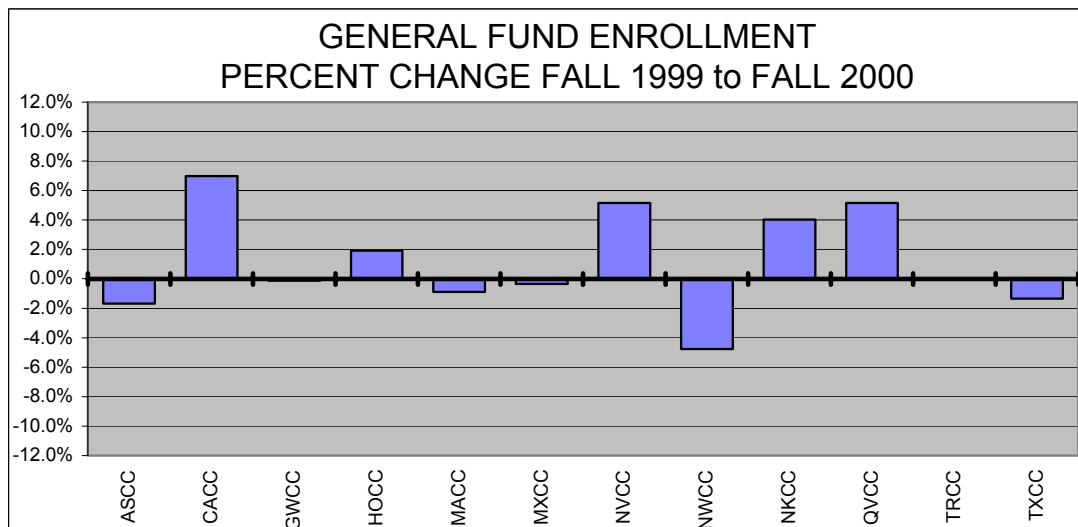

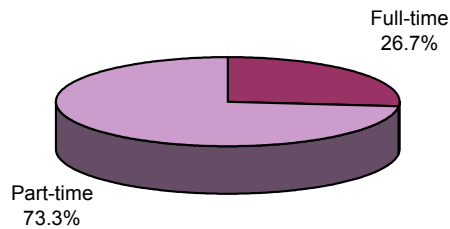

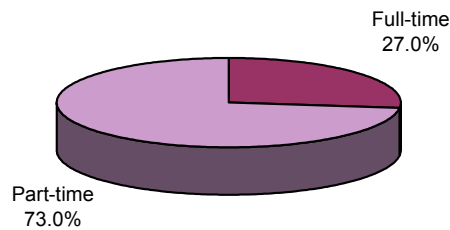
FULL-TIME/PART-TIME

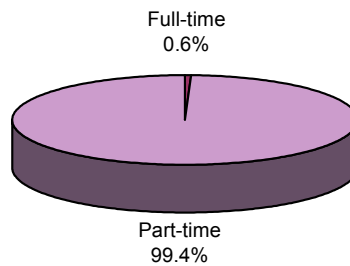
FULL-TIME/PART-TIME

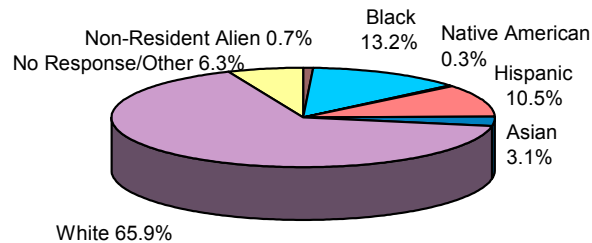

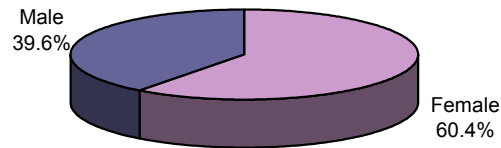
ETHNIC DISTRIBUTION
