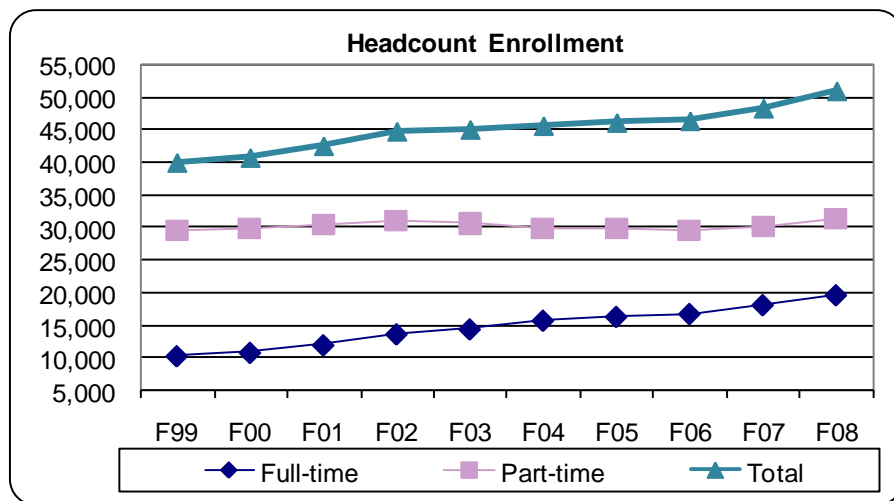

Introduction

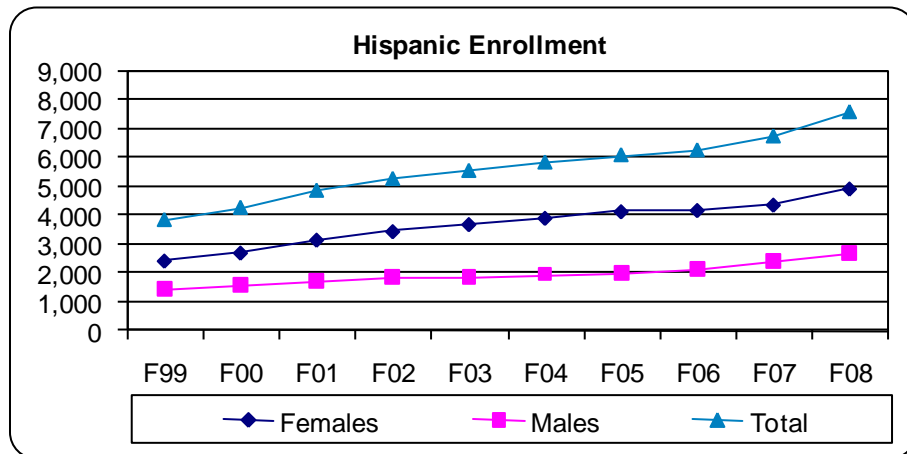
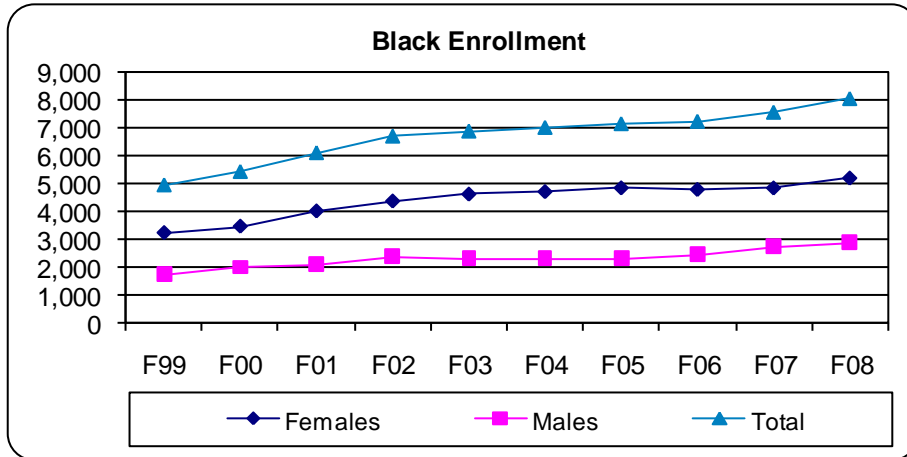
In the Fall of 2008, there are 51,105 students enrolled in the Connecticut Community Colleges in credit courses. This represents a 5.5% increase over Fall 2007, a new high in headcount enrollment. This Fall is also a record-breaking semester with respect to FTE. Our colleges are serving 29,284 Full-time Equivalent Students, the largest number in the system's history. In ten years, there has been a 90% increase in full-time enrollment and an 87% increase in full-time FTE.



In the Fall 2008 semester, 61.5% of all community college students are attending part-time, and 38.5% are attending full-time. Full-time attendance has increased by 24.7% since Fall 2004, while part-time attendance has increased by 4.9%. From 1998 to 2001, part-time students generated more FTE than full-time students. This trend changed in 2002 and as of this Fall, full-time students account for 58.2% of the total FTE generated.

This Fall, 17,357 minority students represent 34% of the student body, a 20.3% increase in minority enrollment since 2004 (30.5% are Black and Hispanic). Over the past five years, significant enrollment increases have occurred for Black males (24%), Black females (10%), Hispanic males (37%) and Hispanic females (26%).

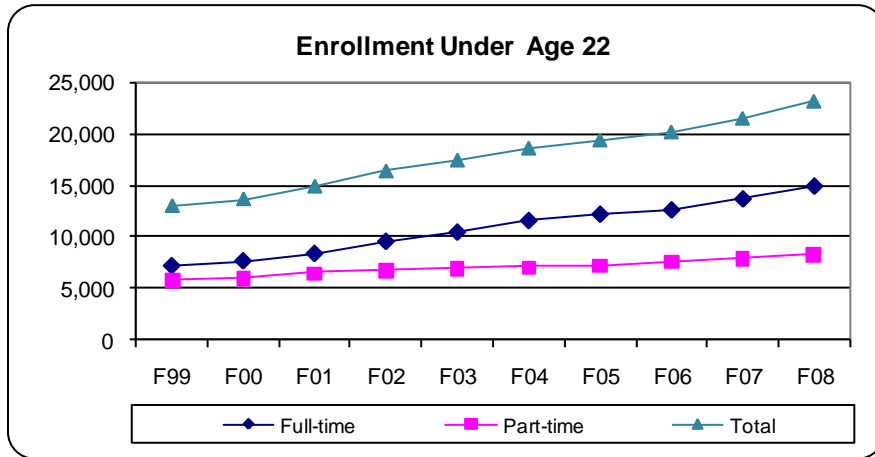
In ten years, Black enrollment has increased by 63% and Hispanic enrollment by 96%.



The system’s gender composition has remained relatively consistent over the past five years. This Fall, 61% of the student body is female and 39% is male.

The average age of the student population is 27; 21 for full-time students and 31 for part-timers. Full-time enrollment continues to increase and these are generally the younger, more “traditional age” college students; 75.6% of them are under the age of 22. Overall 45.6% of our students are under the age of 22. This represents a 24.8% increase since 2004 and is the largest segment of our student body.

In ten years, there has been a 79% increase in students under the age of 22; a 107% increase in full-time students under the age of 22.

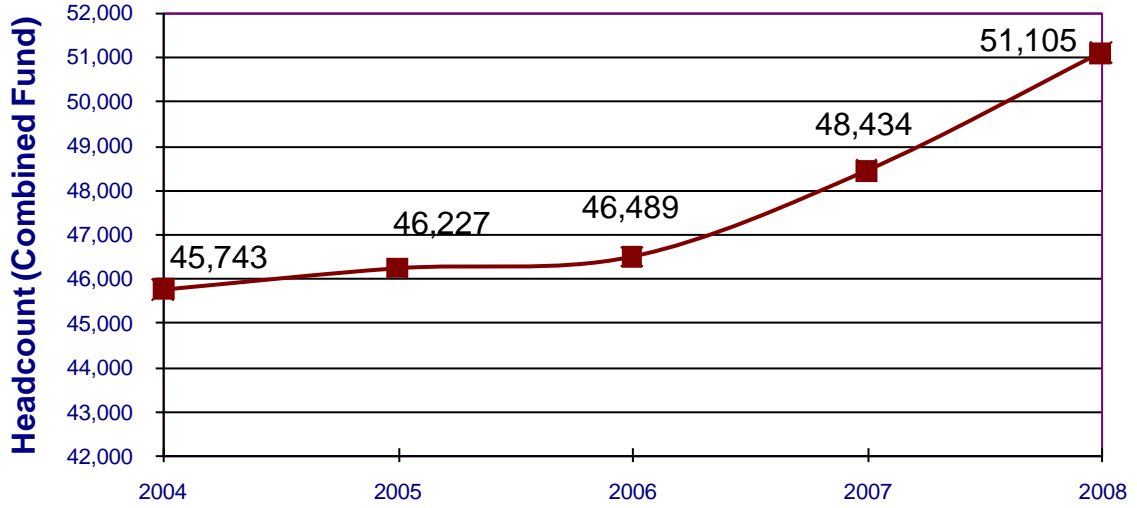


In the Fall of 2008, 44.2% of all community college students are enrolled in occupational programs. Liberal Arts/General Studies programs account for an additional 36.8% and the remaining 19% of the students are not enrolled in a specific degree or certificate program.

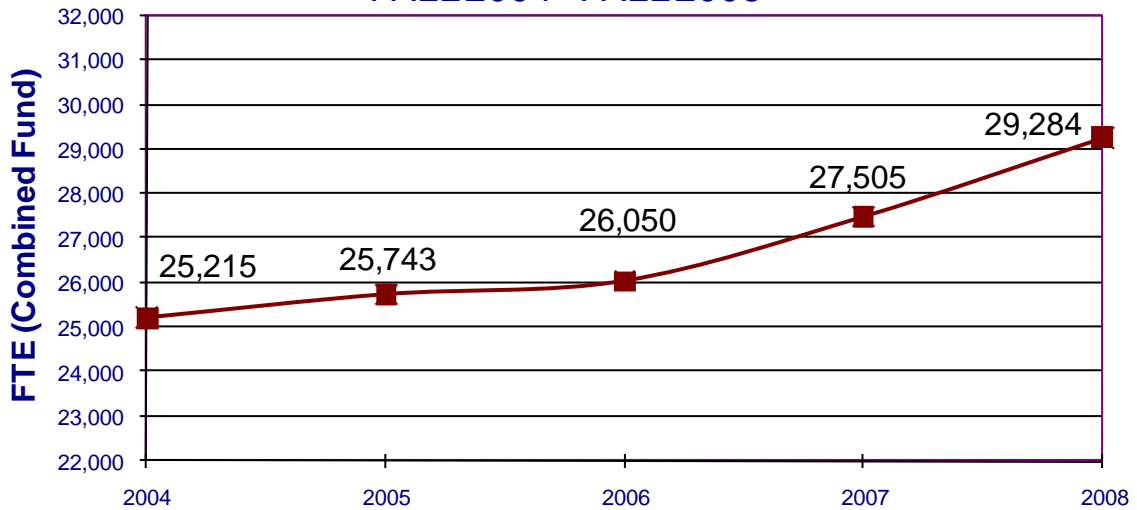
The most popular programs among all students are Liberal Arts/General Studies, Business and Social/Public Services. The most popular programs among female students are Liberal Arts/General Studies, Social/Public Services, Business and Health/Life Sciences. The most popular programs among males are Liberal Arts/General Studies, Business and Science/Engineering/Technology.

Our credit students come from all over the state of Connecticut and represent 50.2% of the total undergraduate student enrollment in public higher education. This Fall, our students reside in 168 of 169 towns (see the map on page 31).

CONNECTICUT COMMUNITY COLLEGES FALL 2004 - FALL 2008

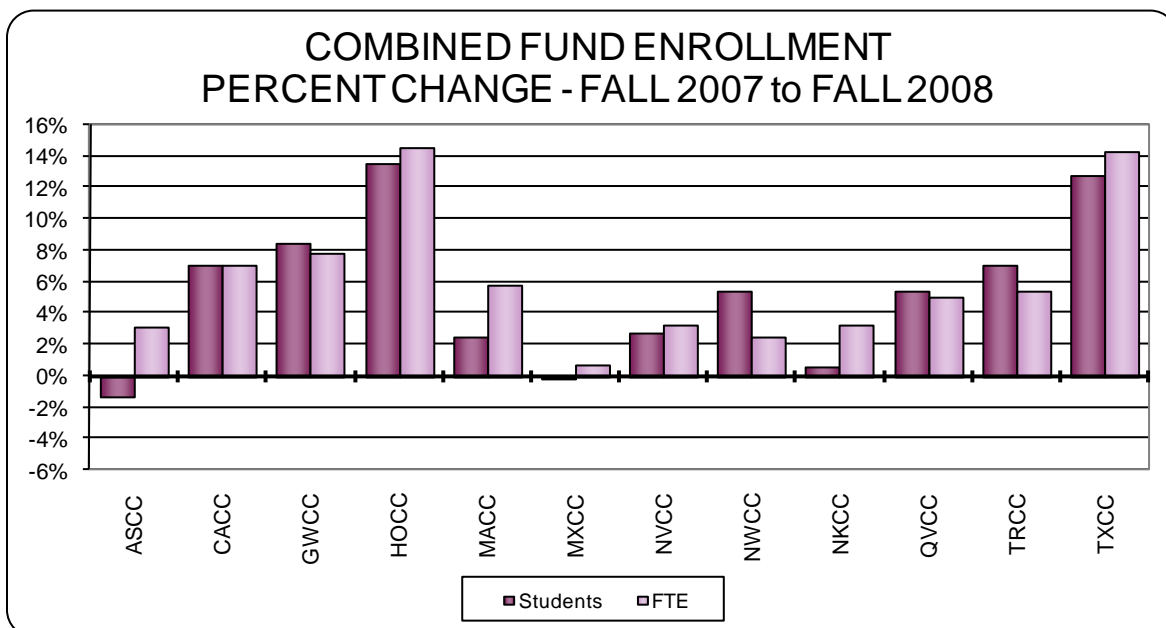


CONNECTICUT COMMUNITY COLLEGES FALL 2004 - FALL 2008



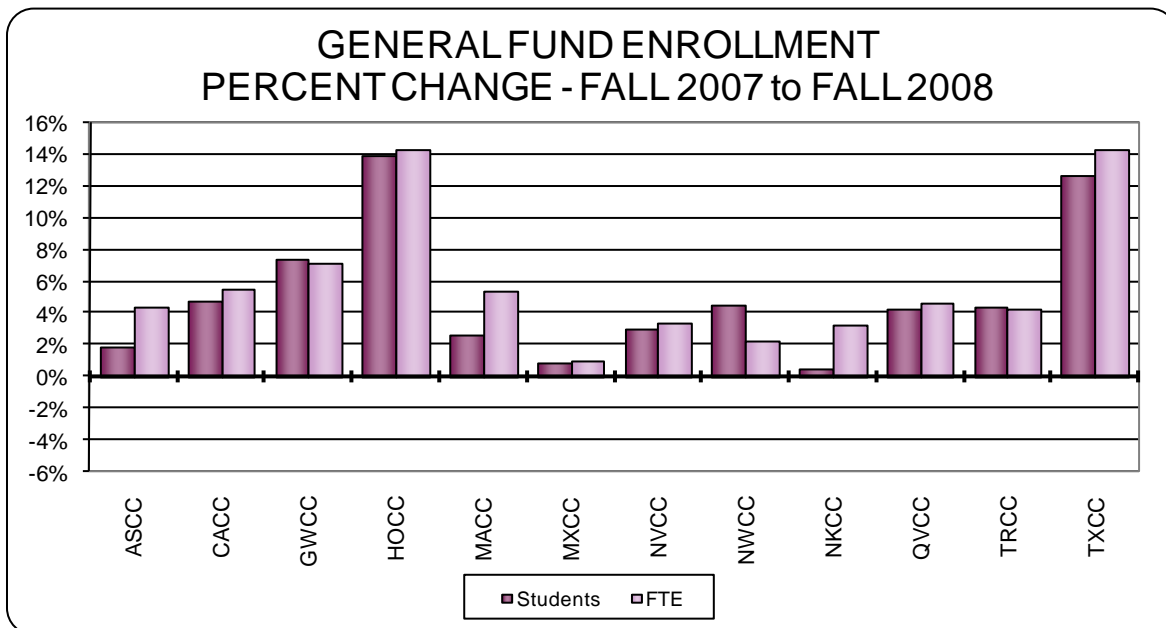

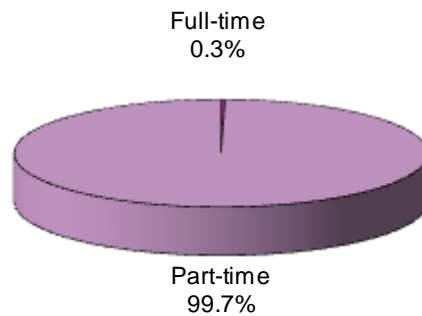
FULL-TIME/PART-TIME

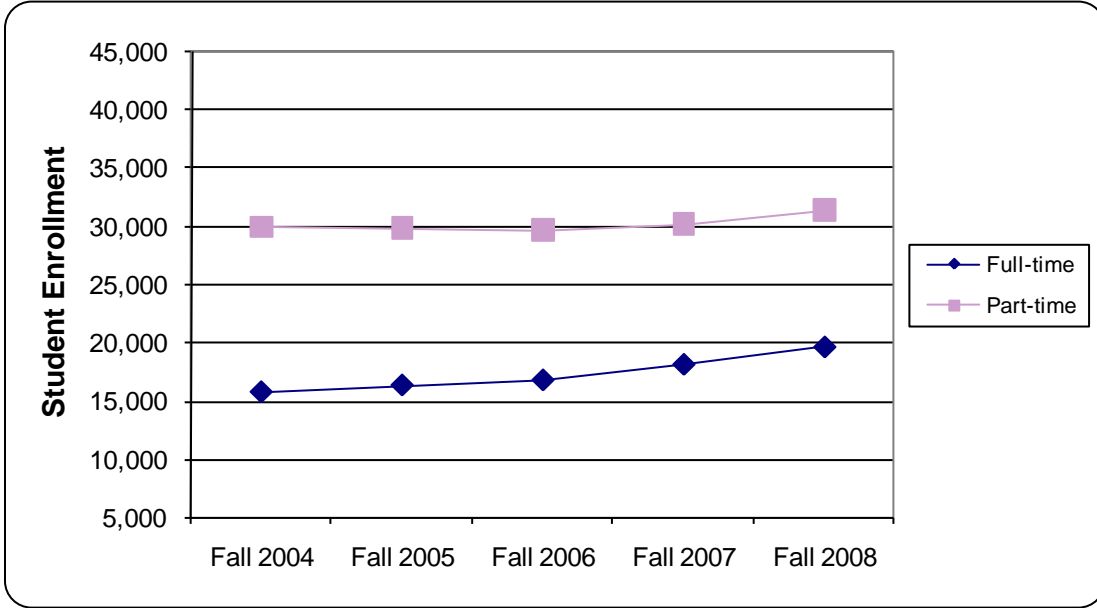

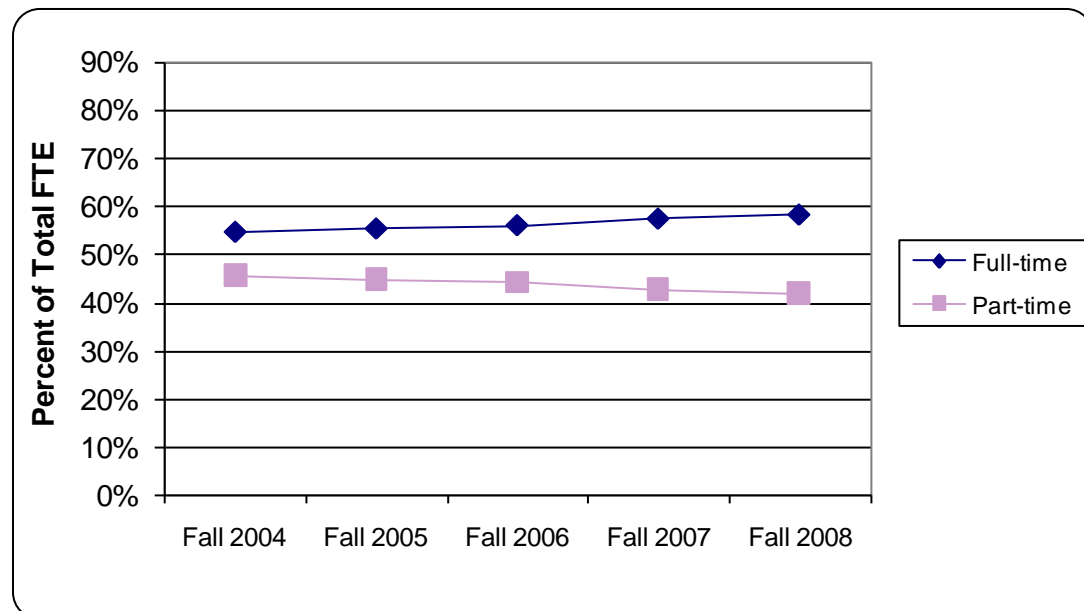

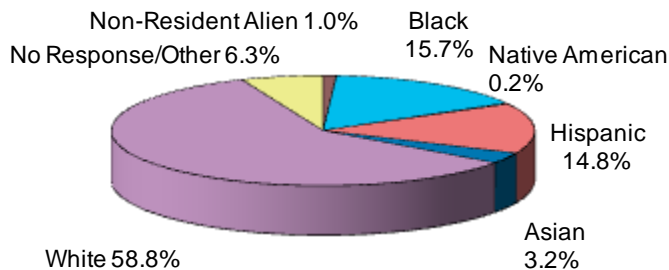

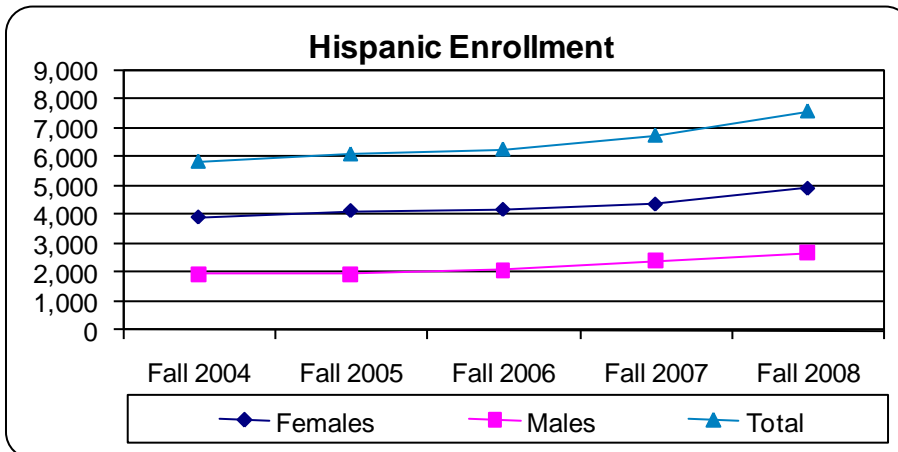

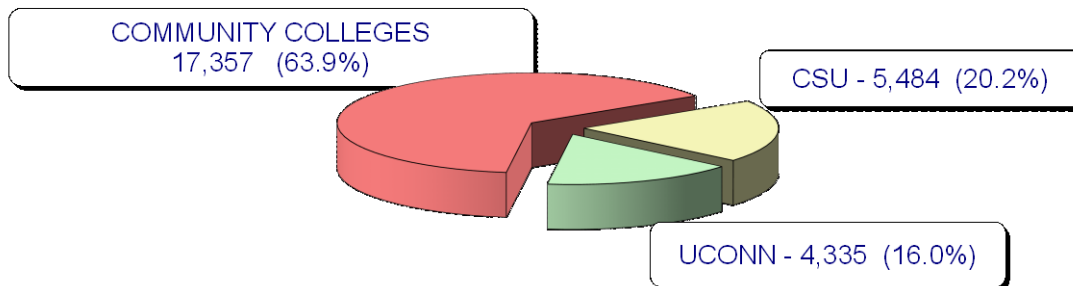
UNDERGRADUATES AT PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS FALL 2008 HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT

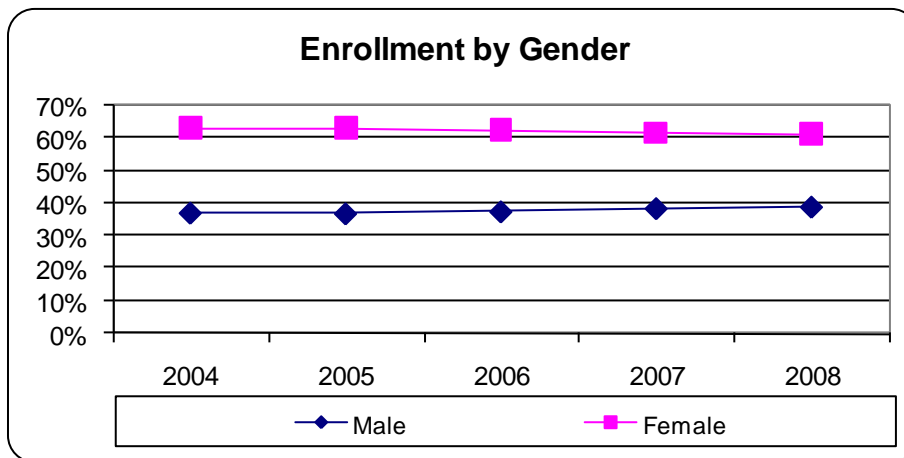

In Fall 2008, 39,236 students (76.8%) are enrolled in degree programs, 2,153 students (4.2%) are enrolled in certificate programs, and the remaining 9,716 students (19%) are not enrolled in a specific degree or certificate program. There is an 8.4% increase in degree program enrollments over last year and an 18.9% increase since 2004. There is a 22.8% decrease in certificate program enrollments over last year and a 16.6% decrease since 2004.



In the Fall of 2008, occupational programs account for 44.2% of all community college students. Liberal Arts/General Studies programs account for an additional 36.8% and the remaining 19% of the students are not enrolled in a specific degree or certificate program. Among the occupational programs, 13.4% of all community college students are enrolled in Business programs, 8% in Health/Life Sciences programs, 6.7% in Science/Engineering/Technology programs, 11.4% in Social/Public Service programs, and 4.6% in Humanities/Arts/Communications, Social Sciences, Education and ESL programs.



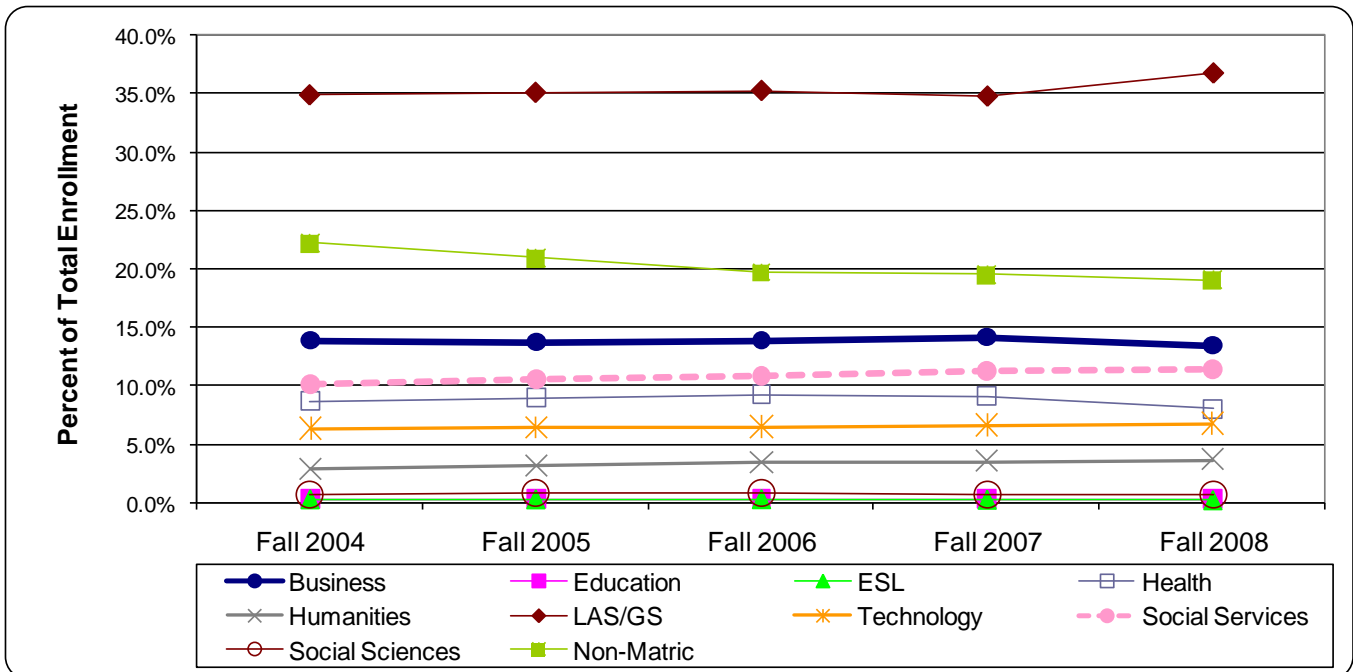
