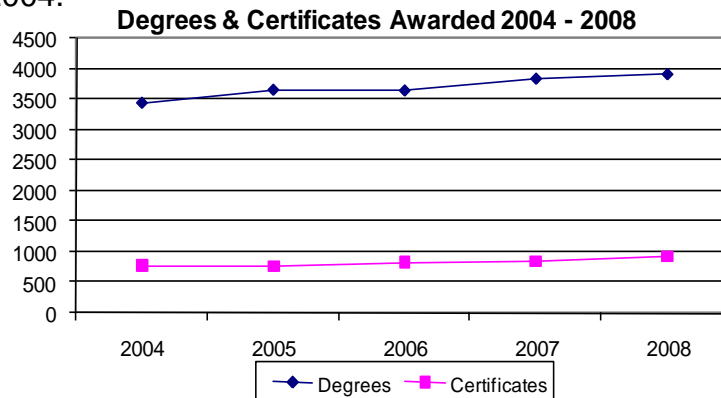

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Introduction

During the 2007-2008 academic year, Connecticut Community Colleges granted 4,838 awards: 3,913 degrees and 925 certificates. This represents a 1.9% increase in degrees awarded over last year and a 13.6% increase since 2004. There is a 3.2% increase in certificates awarded over last year and a 14.6% increase since 2004.

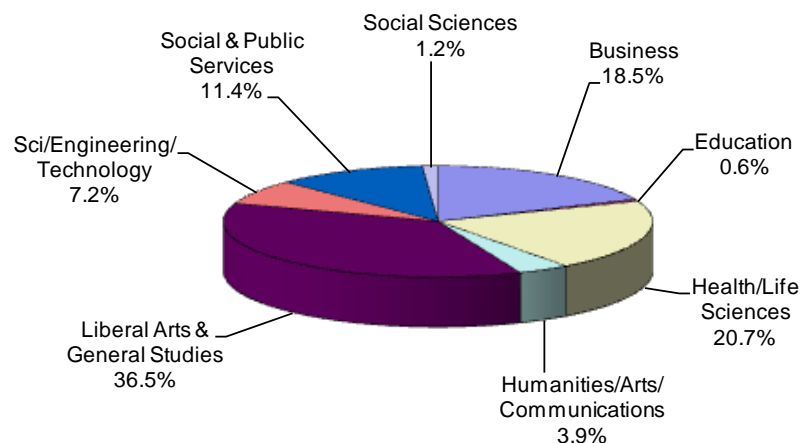


Occupational programs accounted for 63.5% of all the associate degrees awarded. Among the degrees awarded, 18.5% were in Business programs, 20.7% were in Health and Life Sciences programs, 11.4% were in Social and Public Service programs, and 7.2% were in Science, Engineering and Technology programs. Humanities, Arts, Communications, Social Sciences, and Education accounted for the remaining 5.7% of the degrees awarded.

The gender composition of the graduates has remained fairly consistent over the last 5 years. This year, 64.8% of our graduates were female and this past fall, females made up 61.5% of the credit student body. This year, 35.2% of the graduates were male, and this past fall, males made up 38.5% of the credit student body. The most popular programs among female students are Liberal Arts/General Studies, Health/Life Sciences and Business. The popular programs among males are Liberal Arts/General Studies, Science/Engineering/Technology and Business.

The percentage of minority graduates ranges from 25.5% in 2004 to 26.2% in 2008. Last fall, minorities represented 33.1% of the credit student body.

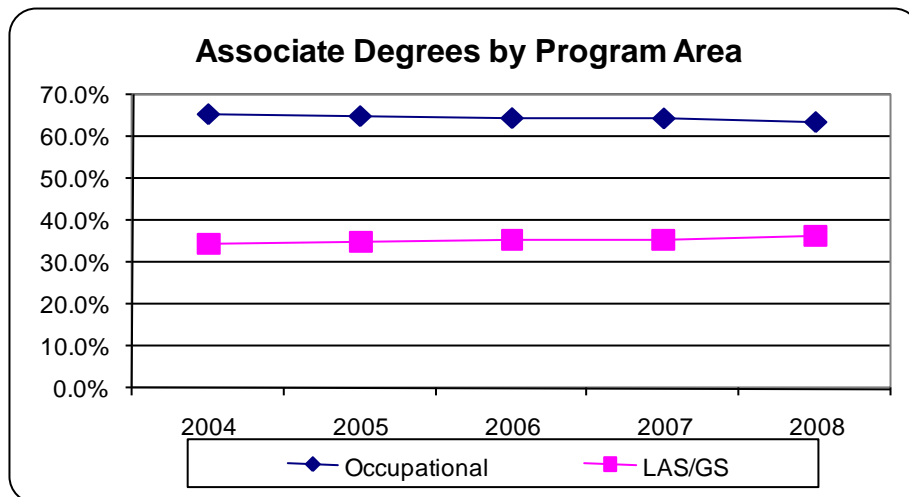
2007-2008 Associate Degrees Awarded



The Connecticut Community Colleges awarded 3,913 associate degrees in 2007-2008. This represents a 1.9% increase over last year and a 13.6% increase since 2004.

Occupational programs account for 63.5% of all associate degrees awarded. The remaining 36.5% are in Liberal Arts and Sciences, and General Studies programs. Among all programs, Liberal Arts & Sciences and General Studies programs provide the largest group of graduates, followed by Health/Life Sciences (20.7%) and Business (18.5%).



The Connecticut Community Colleges also awarded 925 certificates in 2007-2008. This represents a 3.2% increase over last year and a 14.6% increase since 2004.

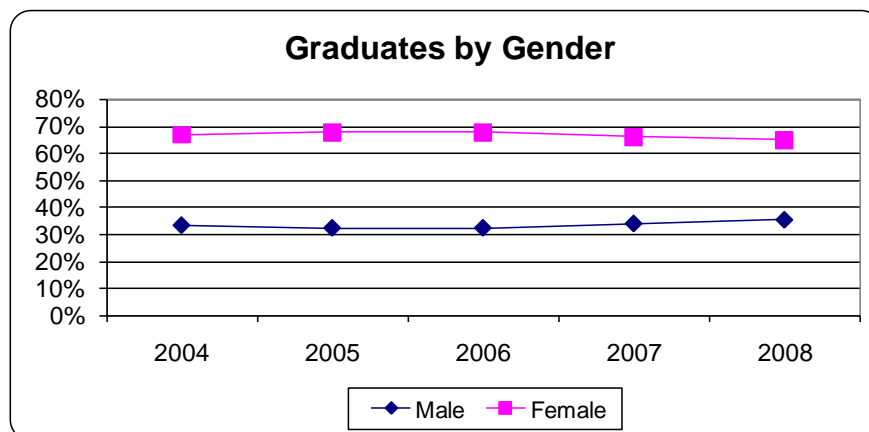
Women earned 66% of the degrees awarded, and men earned 34%. Of the certificates awarded in 2007-2008, women received 60% and men received 40%.

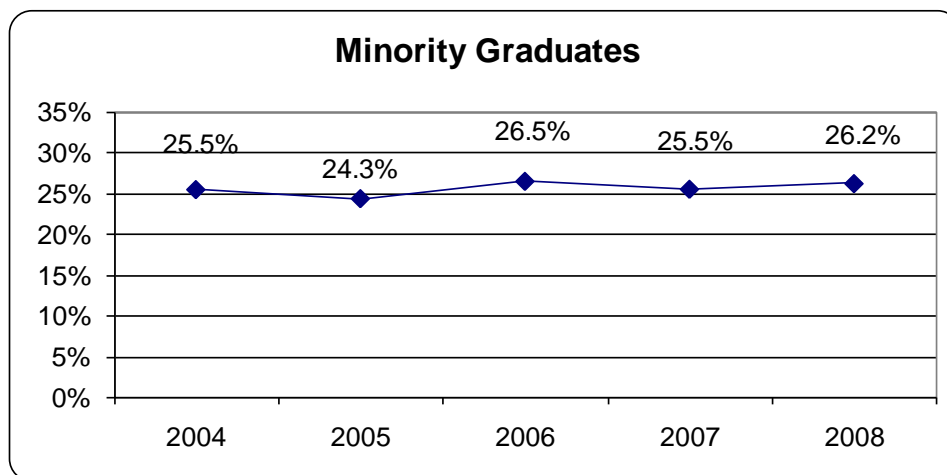
Minority students¹ earned 1,051 (26.9%) of the associate degrees and 216 (23.4%) of the certificates awarded by the community college system.
